In the country and in the company of his son Billy he finds peace and starts to rebuild his life. The stories he tells his son become the much loved Winnie the Pooh books. But with success comes fame and a cost not only on Milne but on Billy, the books' Christopher Robin, who cannot shake loose of his literary alter-ego.
